

Minutes from Street Meeting from Jan. 29 , 2020 with Athens School District

Meeting called to order at 5:30 PM . Attending were Randy Decker , Dwight Lenhard , Steve Brewster , Chuck Kornack , Jeff Mastin , Steve Janke , Ken Ellenbecker , Craig Diedrich and Jamie Handschke .

Topic of discussion was the section of Schlegel Street on the east side of Elementary school . Randy Decker read the proposed options that the village gave to School Supt. Jeff Mastin on 1/3/2020 . The Village street committee recommended option Number 1 , which basically says that the School District should pay for the repairs needed to the street , which will be determined by the Village Street Committee , after the street repairs are done and paid for by the School District , the Village will be responsible for any future street repairs needed . A certified survey should be done to show who clearly owns the new ROW , which could be 60' wide instead of the current 40' width . Survey costs to be School District cost .

School District asked if the Village could move up project sooner than the projected time frame of 2022 – 2024 . Village responded if budget allows this may be possible depending on some higher priority street projects in the village . Jeff Mastin asked if the village could give them a rough estimate so the school district can budget for project . *STEVE JANKE* will give a rough estimate to school district . Next step in this process is to be by the School District to show the Village of Athens that their School Board has agreed to this change , then the Village Board will review the agreement and present to The Village Board board for Approval .

Randy Decker informed the school district attendees that the village plans on doing Mueller Street this year which will affect them because of the property they own on this street , possible curb and gutter cost sharing . Ken Ellenbecker brought up that the schools well to water the football field has not produced enough water in dry years and referred to the wells the village has on their land , village proceeded to tell them that this is a Water and Sewer committee issue and that we will contact Chris Perkins , Chairman of that committee , to address their concerns .

Motion to adjourn by Dwight with second by Steve at 5:55 PM. Motion passed 3-0 .

**#1 – \*\*\*STREET COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION IS OPTION #1**

a- Village repairs street same width (44' wide) as existing (Year: 2022 or 2023?)

b. Pulverize/pave blacktop with possible new curb/gutter and sidewalk

c. School pays for their portion of the street as well as 100% of curb/gutter and sidewalk

d. Village per agreement with school will accept wider ROW and school is not responsible for street repairs in future

e. Survey needed to change ROW or could just have it documented that school is no longer responsible.
