

**ATHENS VILLAGE BOARD MEETING  
MONDAY, JULY 28, 2025, 7:00 PM  
VILLAGE BOARD ROOM**

Meeting was called to order by President Decker at 7:00 PM. Roll call was taken with members Brodziski, Decker, Guden, Perkins, Socha, Thorson and Thurs present. All recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Visitor present was Casey Krautkramer.

Motion Thorson, S/Socha and carried to approve the minutes of the 6/23/25 committee meeting.

Committees reporting were: **Finance & Personnel** –Trustee Thorson reported budget season is approaching. **Fire & Police** –Trustee Thurs reported that he met with Chief Stencil about possibly needing to update the tasers and regarding finding a taser certified instructor as well as exploring the purchase of Flock cameras. **Streets** –Trustee Brodziski reported that he received bids for miscellaneous sidewalk and catch basin work. **Parks & Public Welfare** – Trustee Guden reported that Jeff from the DNR marked the trees at Erbach and will bring in a tree disease specialist before presenting a plan. He also reported that the Athens Park bathroom project is complete and the overhead electrical line was reconnected with the possibility of having an underground line in the future. **Public Property**- Trustee Socha reported that the siren has been repaired and that the batteries are good for the remainder of the season. The timer could be reprogrammed for a 6 minute run cycle but would have to have a 15 minute cool down cycle. **Water & Sewer** – Trustee Perkins reported that the treatment plant project will hopefully get started this fall.

Motion Thorson, S/Brodziski and carried to approve payment of check #28069 to #28131 totaling \$196,492.53.

Motion Perkins, S/Guden and carried to approve waiver of Village Ordinance 161-26 Alcoholic Beverages in Public Areas for the 2025 Athens Fair, August 14-17, 2025 with the exception that parade participants are not included in waiver as outlined in Village Ordinance 161-26(c).

Motion Perkins, S/Brodziski and carried to approve Operator's Licenses for Savannah Stendel and Emily Passehl

Motion Perkins, S/Thorson and carried to approve Resolution 2025-7 Final Resolution Authorizing Special Assessments for Maple Street project.

Motion Socha, S/Thurs and carried to approve 4 year Warning Siren maintenance contract with Sheboygan Warning Signals.

Motion Brodziski, S/Thorson and carried to approve quote from Switlick and Sons for \$7800 for catch basin and miscellaneous sidewalk ramp repairs.

Motion Perkins, S/Guden and carried to adjourn at 7:26pm.
